

Opening Day Rules and Regulations for Parents and Players Meeting:

Parents:

- We use the Remind 101 system to keep all coaches informed on game time changes. If you would like to be notified, please send a text of _____ to _____.
- Due to construction on campus this year, getting to fields 2, 3, & 4 can be difficult. We will explain how to drive to each field at the end of our meeting, but STRONGLY encourage EVERYONE today to take the shuttle buses. After today, you will feel much more comfortable with the layout on campus and know that you can always park at the dorms and take a shuttle bus up to the fields. **EXPLAIN HOW TO GET TO THE FIELDS AND PARKING AT THE END.**
- If you purchased a BBQ ticket for tonight, you will need that ticket in order to get your meal. At this point, due to the high amount of dinners ordered, we CANNOT sell anymore tickets for tonight's BBQ, but our CONCESSION STAND will be open (CASH ONLY).
- The BBQ will take place during or near the end of the skills competition at the field you are playing at.

Players:

- For today you will NEED: Your Water Bottle, Molded/Rubber Cleats, baseball equipment, AND warm up balls. Catchers will NOT need their gear for the catchers throw in the skills competition.
 - Players should always be supervised by a coach or adult. If you are in the game room, at the pool, or playing wiffle ball outside, you **MUST** have a coach with you
 - Stay away from the pond on campus, it looks pretty, but you will get a rash if you go in. Do not bring animals back to the dorms or fields.
 - Stay out of the construction areas at all times (elaborate) – this is the time of year when the college does many of their improvements before the school year begins, so please pardon the appearance as well.
 - No cleats in buildings or buses – you must have a pair of slides or sneakers for the buses, buildings and inside the cafeteria
 - Coaches –do not give the room keys to your kids, if they lose them, it is \$125 off the deposit you left to replace them you hold them and open rooms for them
 - DO NOT drag the bat bags down the stairs or through the halls
 - **Please, no running in the dorms or the dining halls.** The halls get slippery due to the humidity, so we don't want anyone getting hurt.
 - No water balloons, squirt guns, B.B. guns or fireworks, fart spray, or stink bombs – if we catch you, you are suspended for 2 games
 - Do not touch the fire-alarms or the blue emergency phones. If you are caught, it will be a 2 game suspension.

- Take care of your garbage in the dorms (no trash in the stairwells), and in the dining hall, put trays where they belong
 - Curfew is 10 pm back inside the building, Lights out 10:30
 - Game room closes at 10 pm sharp

- No balls of any kind are to be used in the rooms, hallways, or game room
- When you leave your room, always close the door!! A wide open room is asking for trouble.
- **No throwing hard baseballs in or outside of the buildings**
- If you break something or you have issues in your room, please let us know right away so we can get it fixed
- We cannot give rides to players on our golf carts, but will try to accommodate families, especially anyone who is handicapped with our golf carts whenever possible.
- Parents must sign out players when they are leaving campus and sign them back in at the front desk when they return
- Your child must be back by 10pm. If they are not, the first time they will get a warning, the 2nd time they will get an automatic one game suspension the next day!
- Players cannot spend the night outside of the dorms without permission from the infirmary for medical reasons only – must be signed back in at infirmary by 6am, no exceptions made
- Parents can only visit your children in the dorms between 6 – 9pm (safety reasons). If you wish to pick them up prior to room visiting hours you just need to make arrangements to meet them in the lobby.
- Dining hall is free to players & coaches only - parents must pay for each meal to eat at the door
- No alcoholic drinking on campus. Those who are caught will be removed from the camp on a permanent basis.
- No tobacco at the fields, in or near the buildings
- Parking is available in designated Student or Commuter (green or yellow) parking only: **AFTER TODAY YOU WILL RECEIVE A TICKET.**
- Parents are not allowed in the dugouts for any reasons! You are also not permitted on the field during the Skill Competitions today.
- **Parents are not allowed on the fields or in the dugouts, at any time during game play to take pictures!!!!**
- Any derogatory language at the field may result in your removal from the fields. Remember, this is about the kids and derogatory language is not tolerated.
- **Even on a sunny day, each game may begin 30 mins prior to their scheduled game times so plan on being their earlier!**
- Infirmary is on the 1st floor of Matteson Hall – room 114
- The sales room is on the Main floor of Matteson Hall. It is open Saturday, Sunday, Monday and Thursday
- Concession stands at Fields 1, 3 4 and 6 only
- **Please be aware there are permanent bathrooms at all Fields except Field #4, which does have a port-o-jon**
- The opening night BBQ will take place after the skills competition at the field you are on.
- There is NO parking on Blodgett Drive which leads up the hill, but there is a side street you may park on across from Field 2 (limited parking).

- You cannot park at the Tan & Brown apartment complex at the top of Blodgett Drive, that is private property and your car will be towed.
